
Current E-ID-landscape of Switzerland: A mess




E-ID: Planned next steps

- Public Sandbox Trust Infrastructure (since end of March 2023)
- Technical Advisory Circle (start September 2023)
- Approval of the draft law and message by the Federal Council (end of 2023)
- Tech Proposal Discussion Paper (end of 2023)
- Start parliamentary debate (start of 2024)
- eLFA pilot canton AR (start of 2024), for all cantons (end of 2024)
- Tech decision (Q1 2024)
- Approval of E-ID-law, potential referendum (earliest end of 2025)
- Launch E-ID (earliest beginning of 2026)


Decentralized trust infrastructure
